

These rolls are perfect for teaching the Easter story. The marshmallow represents Jesus who was placed inside the cave after his death. A rock was rolled over the opening to seal it shut. On the third day, the tomb was found empty! "He is not here; he has risen!"

Resurrection Buns

Recipe:

375 degree oven - 8 to 10 minutes

- 1 can of refrigerated crescent rolls - 8 count
- 8 Large Marshmallows
- 3 Tbs. Melted Butter
- Sugar and Cinnamon mixture (2 tsp. Cinnamon/3 Tbs. Granulated sugar)

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees and line a baking sheet with parchment paper.

2. Unroll crescent roll dough and separate into triangles.

3. Combine sugar and cinnamon in a small bowl.

4. Dip each marshmallow in butter and then coat in cinnamon sugar. Place in the middle of a piece of dough.

5. Roll dough around marshmallow, sealing the seams really well. Position so seam is facing down. Sprinkle a little more cinnamon sugar on top.

6. Bake for 8 - 10 minutes.
