

# Father's Day Fish Change Holder

## Materials Needed:

Cardstock

Air Dry Modeling Clay

Straw

Plastic bag

6" diameter Styrofoam Bowl

Plastic knife

Paint – 2 oz. bottle of acrylic craft paint - your choice of color for your Fish

Optional – Clear Acrylic Sealer

Permanent Marker to sign and date.

Downloaded Pattern



## Directions:

Download and print pattern on cardstock.

Lay a plastic bag on a table, and roll out or flatten clay on top of it. \*Try to roll out at least 1/4"- 1/3" thick.

Lay pattern on top of clay and help your child cut out the fish.

Make scales and eye with the end of a straw.

You can use a little bit of water on the edges to smooth out.

Gently pick up fish (still on the plastic bag) and lay into the Styrofoam bowl.

Let air dry. (Usually a day or two)

Gently lift the fish out of the bowl. Turn the fish bowl over so the bottom can dry.

When completely dry, paint desired color.

Seal with Clear Acrylic Sealer if desired.

Be sure to write your child's name and the date on the back of the bowl.
